

Today the Family Relationship Centre is fully equipped with experienced staff members including mediators and family advisors, public access to a wealth of information and advice, and all encased in a modern, relaxed and welcoming atmosphere.

Rockhampton Family Relationship Centre is also taking the opportunity to reflect over key achievements of the past year including the establishment of the Indigenous Service, a placement in Emerald extending Rockhampton's on-hand services, community event contributions (such as NAIDOC Week involvement) and extensive outreach and networking within the community.

Rockhampton Family Relationship Centre is an Australian Government initiative, and is auspiced by Centacare, a Rockhampton Catholic Diocese community welfare agency, offering a range of services for families in the region in a welcoming and safe environment.

As part of its services, the Centre offers a dispute resolution service for separated couples, as well as services for grandparents and other extended family members, who want to resolve parenting issues and make parenting plans without going to court.

The Rockhampton Family Relationship Centre mediation service is free and available to anyone in new parenting or separated parent situations where arrangements are required for children after separation.
