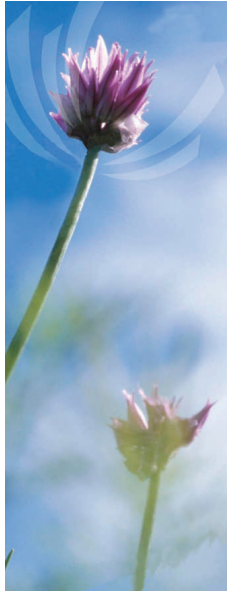

Needing Allied Health Services?

There are a number of services available for the frail aged, people with a disability and the carers of these people, to help them remain in their own homes.

Some people may just need assistance to maintain optimal mental health and wellbeing (known as allied health).

Allied Health

Centacare offers professional allied health services and may refer you to specialist Services, including:

- ➔ Counselling and workshops
- ➔ Social work, dietician or nutritionist advice
- ➔ Referrals to Podiatry, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy

How is a referral made?

Anyone can make a referral. Referrals can be made directly to Centacare staff during business hours. Assessments are done using the Home and Community Care services (HACC) Ongoing Needs Identification Tool (ONI) to decide whether you are eligible for a service and what type of service you need to assist you to remain living at home.

Confidentiality is assured at all times.

The Allied Health Program

Who is eligible?

You may be eligible for the HACC SAIL Program if you are a frail older person or a person with a disability who would like to become more independent.

What is the cost?

Contributions are encouraged and these funds assist in providing more services to more people. Contributions are discussed with clients and usually range from \$5 - \$10 per hour. Services are offered in town and district.
