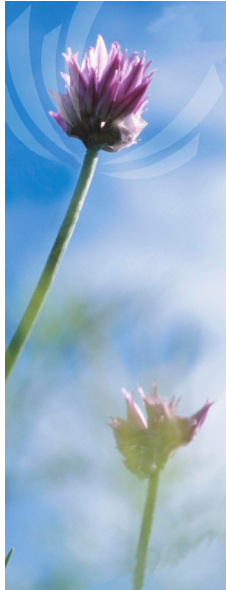

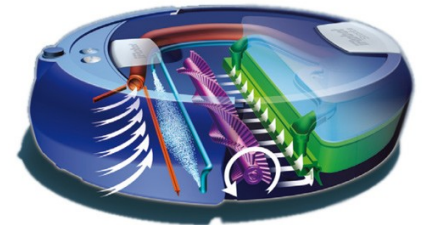

HACC Smart Assistive Technology Demonstration Project

Smart Assistive Technology Demonstration Project

This 12 month project is funded by the Home and Community Care Program to assess the benefits of smart assistive technology in promoting independence for frail aged and younger people with a disability and their carers living in the community.

Who is eligible?

Clients will

- be HACC eligible
- be willing to participate in the project
- agree to trial smart assistive technology
- agree to ongoing assessment as necessary
- be supported with introduction and use of technology
- have ongoing support and monitoring from Centacare staff
- provide feedback on the effects of the technology on an ongoing bases during the project

How does it work?

We are keen to use smart assistive technology with clients

- who require assistance to manage the impact of degenerative disease such as early dementia, osteoarthritis Parkinson disease
- have a vision impairment
- have difficulties with managing domestic assistance and yard maintenance
- need assistance with social access for shopping outings and leisure activities

Some of the smart technology we have introduced in past and that we plan to trial further include:

- Robotic vacuum Roomba and the robotic floor cleaner the Scooba
- Emergency call systems
- Sensor lights in home
- Safety key box for easier access for emergency services
- Any other aids to improve function mobility and access in the community

Life Tec Qld are partners in project and they have a data base of over 5 000 aids to assist and promote independence
